DNRO ACTION MEMORANDUM NO. 6

SUBJECT: Terms of Reference for Task Group on Status of Effort on Photographic Sensor Subsystem for a New Search/ Surveillance System

I. PURPOSE:

a. To provide information to the DNRO which he can use to assist him in determining actions at the camera contractors both before and during source selection. In accomplishing this purpose, the present and projected status of the effort on each of the designs of a photographic sensor subsystem under consideration for a new satellite search and surveillance system will be determined.

II. RESULTS DESIRED:

- a. The results of this review will be summarized in a written report. This report will include, in a form which permits easy comparison, at least the following:
- (i) Decaground: The funding, project objectives, direction, and authorization, manpower, etc., given to date. This background should only go back as far as pertinent (for example: prior expert Fig. on alternative design concepts is not required).
- (2) Present Status: The state, as of the date of the review, of system design, contractor analyses (lens, focus, film handling, synchronimation or vest thermal, error budgets, etc); of tests, experiments and/or breadboard demonstrations, and/or breadboard demonstrations, and/or breadboard demonstrations. assembled, sic. The report should clearly differentiate between tasks already completed, in progress, and those to be initiated.

- d. The Task Group should keep in mind that this is a fact-finding undertaking. It is not a preliminary source selection, a technical analysis of the competitive designs, nor a judgment on the appropriateness of direction given to the contractor, or of contractor competence.
- e. The Task Group will submit its report to the DNRO not later than 1500 hours, December 13, 1965.
