SUBJECT: Information Policy on MCL Program

Dear Colonel Miller:

Reference your letter SSZ - 2 Dec 66 concerning the identification of the MCL Program which was included in a list of space programs active at General Electric, in G.E. recruiting advertising.

General Electric regrets that it misinterpreted the MCL Information policies as outlined in the briefing by the four different Air Force and DOD representatives, F. Burnham, L. W. Lilley, R. Hemann, and E. Futtner, 13 Feb 66 at SED. Immediate action has been taken to insure these policies will be strictly followed at all times.

Mr. Eugene Alberts, Chief of Security Review, Space Systems Division, and I discussed a specific clearance problem relating to a proposed G.E. article on MCL for internal use in the Company, and during my two phone conversations we both reviewed the MCL Information Policy, although recruiting advertising in the style noted in this letter was not discussed.

We sincerely recognize the MCL Information Policy has a contractual requirement and intend at all times to adhere to it. The described deviation to this policy was a result of an unintentional error on my part due to bad notes that I took at the 13 Feb 66 meeting at SED.

Copies of your TXK have been sent to all pertinent MCL management personnel as well as other G.E. activities concerned with internal and external release of information about G.E. involved programs. I personally have talked to these same people about the TXK and we have written to subcontractors about the Policy. Please be assured that we have done the necessary communications of this Policy and we have the channels for clearance and interpretation of the Policy in place and operating.

Since the February meeting our system has worked well except for two incidents: (1) a misdirected clearance to DOD direct rather than through the proper channel, SSD (my previously mentioned conversation with Gene Alberta), and (2) the misinterpretation of using the letters **NOI** in a list of active G.E. space programs in recruiting advertising.

Again, we regret the misinterpretation, and have taken the necessary actions to prevent non-conformance to the **NOI Information Policy**.
