Dr. Flax:

Attached (Tab A) is a summary chart of MOL Program options (content/costs/schedules) at the \$530 and \$500 million levels in FY 69, and approximately \$600 million in FY 70.

Options A-1 and A-2 represent stretch-outs of the present program. Options B-1 and B-2 are "manned-only" programs, in that they include the completion of Phase 1B for the unmanned system in FY 69, add a fourth manned launch for planning purposes to fill in the future gap, but defer further unmanned-unique development until FY 70 or later. Although all four program options show \$600 million in FY 70, cost estimates varied up to \$\$10 million from that figure (for example, option A-2 was \$607 million; option B-1 was \$592 million); however, our in-house estimating process is not all that precise until we work the problem with the contractors. Finally, all options contemplate the same manageable variance (e.g., so-called "exposure") at end-FY 69 as at end FY-68.

We very much need to provide General Bleymaier some program content/funding level information to-day or tomorrow so that appropriate consultation/direction actions with the Associate Contractors can be taken. He is scheduling a meeting with them early next week. With regard to funding/content options, I believe we could start at a \$530 million level for either the baseline or "manned-only" options and adjust back, if necessary, to \$500 million in 2-3 months without undue disruption. Likewise, I believe we could start on the realigned program and revert back to the baseline program in a few months at the same funding level without too much disruption. However, I do not feel we could start the fiscal year at the \$530 million level on the realigned program,

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proceed several months, and then adjust back both to \$500 million and the baseline program without considerable disruption.

For the reasons set forth in the draft letter to SecDef prepared earlier this month (Tab B), I still favor the "manned-only" approach, completing Phase 1B on schedule by the end of this calendar year, and then deferring further unmanned-unique effort until some time in FY 70 or later. Also, since the Phase 1B effort will be underway for the next six months, the final confirmation of the decision to realign the program will not be made until the FY 70 budget level is established.

With your and/or Dr. Brown's concurrence, I would like to send the attached message (Tab C) to General Bleymaier not later than tomorrow. Mr. Palley has seen this package and concurs.

P.S. I will explore further with of funding a future portion of the MOL Program in the Procurement Appropriation. For example, we probably could substantiate funding the T-IIIM's (after the first two) and the Gemini B's (after the unmanned qualification launch) in that account -- and perhaps one or more of the laboratory vehicles if desired. This would not impact on FY 69, but could impact on FY 70 (the total MOL requirements would not change, but the RDT&E load could be lessened in FY 70 and beyond). The and I will discuss our thoughts with you prior to my initiating any action with the budget people.
