MEMORANDUM FOR COLONEL FORD, ASSISTANT FOR THE MOL PROGRAM

SUBJECT: Disposition of MOL Program CITE Equipment

In my memorandum of September 23, 1969 to Dr. Seamans on disposition of Automatic Data Processing Equipment from the MOL Program, we recommended transferring one set of CITE equipment with a modified SDS 9300 computer to the Air Force Office of Scientific Research for support of accelerator work at Florida State University. I understand that the remaining two 9300 computers from the CITE Program are being reported as excess in accordance with ASPR and will be referred to the Air Force Directorate of Data Automation. I further understand that the remaining two CITE units are in partial degrees of completion (approximately 25% and 15%) and are under control of the MOL Systems Office at SAMSO.

The Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army for R&D has recently made a request for the two remaining CITE units in partial completion and the two supporting SDS 9300 computers (Atch 1). This equipment would be used in a systems simulation being incorporated as a part of the Army Missile Command's Advanced Concept Development Facility at Redstone Arsenal. Our discussions with the Army indicate that the use of this equipment will save them over two million dollars.

Since the Air Force has no future plans for the remaining two CITE units and a check with the Directorate of Data Automation indicates that the two remaining SDS 9300 computers will be surplus to Air Force needs, please take appropriate action to transfer these items to the Army. The Army point of contact is Colonel Grayson Tate, Office of the Army Assistant Secretary for R&D, Extension 72615.


