

2. Reference 1a requires contractor excess ADPE be reported to DSAH-LSR for screening as soon as it is possible to project a release date or when it is determined that it is no longer required on the contract.

3. Reference 1b directed that certain MOL excess ADPE be reported to DSA; enclosure 1 indicates equipment that has not been reported to date. Failure to report is delaying reutilization of equipment required by Air Force, as indicated on enclosure 2, and DoD-wide screening of the remaining equipment.

4. Request reports of excess be expedited for ADPE listed on enclosure 1.
