MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: General Goddard's Visit

I accompanied General Goddard to NPIC on October 26 and in the company of [REDACTED] General Goddard received apparently a very fine briefing and reception by Art Lundahl. The old gentleman was highly impressed and was extremely pleased to have been able to receive the briefings over the two day period. He was also pleased that Dr. McLucas was able to spend some time with him on the 25th. Mr. Katz decided apparently to remain in the background and no problem was caused by his desire to crack the door of NPIC. I debriefed General Goddard late in the afternoon of October 26, impressing upon him that he could talk to no one about what he saw, even those he knew to be accessed to the information. General Goddard's entire visit was extremely nostalgic and probably worthwhile.
