SUBJECT: Control of Launching Information on NRP Programs

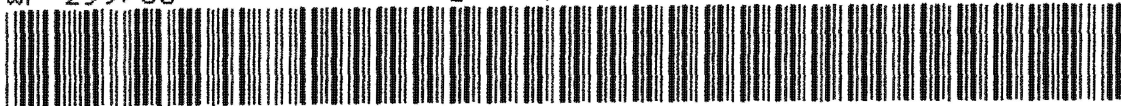
