


Recently we have again reviewed our specific requirements for Gemini support hardware which we would like to use in the MOL Program. The attached list represents equipment which is desired to be made available to the MOL Program from the NASA Gemini Program. Of course, as our Contract Definition Phase progresses the requirements may change somewhat and we may have to come to you with additional or revised requests. You will note that on some items the need date is immediate and, therefore, we would appreciate your expediting this request.
