SUBJECT: MCL Comparison Study Briefing for the Secretary of Defense

In early July 1966, a MCL presentation was given to Mr. McNemara on the West Coast. During discussions at that presentation Dr. Brown suggested that it would be useful for Mr. McNemara to review at some later date additional information relative to the performance of the DCRIAN sensor. In response, a prepentation was prepared, structured as a resume of the factors important to achieving ground resolution with the MCL/DCRIAN cemera, together with a summary of the recent comparisons of a wholly usuammed system using the DORIAN camera, with the MCL configuration.

On 1 September 1966, when you were not available, Dr. Brown was given a "dry run" of this presentation at his request.

With but few changes, Dr. Brown agreed with the scope and content of the presentation, and requested that it be reduced to printed form accompanied by a brief narrative text. It was Dr. Brown's intention to foreward the presentation in this form to Mr. McNamura for information, and to note that a verbal briefing was also available if more detail was desired.
