When GE solicited bids for this subcontract, they preferred firm fixed-price bids and expected quotes in the neighborhood of \$6 or \$7 million. The responses were as follows:

\$4.094 million

The small cost difference is more than offset by the type of contract. The bids, incidentally, typify the different responsiveness and attitudes of the two contractors noted throughout the competition.

After subsequent deliberations, GE has decided that they prefer now to contract at a fixed-price incentive basis and plan to negotiate the following contract:
