MEMORANDUM TO COLONEL BATTLE

SUBJECT: MOL Readout Capability

On July 22, 1968, Mr. H. Bried of the General Electric Company visited the undersigned to discuss the development of a photographic readout capability for the MOL. The G.E. effort is in support of their advanced planning studies for MOL and General Stewart's expressed desire to eventually include a readout capability.

Realizing that funding limitations presently negate the incorporation of readout in the baseline program, G.E. is presently investigating applicable developments for application in a follow-on program. Therefore, they would like to discuss the subject with CBS Labs, but desire to comply with established procedures of concerned agencies. We discussed the matter with Lt Col Cohen (in TDY from L.A.). He suggested that G.E. discuss the system with Lt Col Skantze at the Systems Office if they wish, and that upon his return to the West Coast, Lt Col Cohen will arrange with SP for a G.E. conference with CBS Labs.

This was entirely satisfactory with Mr. Bried, and he would also like to discuss the subject with you at your convenience, if you so desire.
